Unfortunately, Woodhouse is in the top 10% for health related issues in the country. Working at the garden, our health workers will try to help by giving advice and support to individuals. This project is for anyone who feel they can benefit from spending time on this new, unique project.

We will plan the Garden to help with education-based activities. We will have a section for mini-beast and local wildlife. Also set out in our plans is, to show parents and children how things grow and the importance of healthy eating.

We will also cultivate plants and flowers to transfer into planters placed around the local community. Partnerships with schools and local nurseries we hope will take part in this activity.

By Summer 2016, the garden project will be able to achieve some of these small goals. By January 2017 it will be able to achieve these goals in full.
