PCSO Update

- DPPO going well and the word is getting round the community
- Rich Pickings is an initiative that helps prevent thefts from garden sheds. Please don't leave anything outside either for thieves or scrap vans operating in the area.
- There's not a specific gang operating in Woodhouse but there has been a general increase in crime relating to thefts mostly due to scrap vans. Please report incidents so that these can be addressed.
- David Jacobs asked for the community to support the police and not knock what they're doing and report we need to be passing on information in the correct way.
- Please report non-emergency incidents 0114 2202020 or 101
- Mike Peat asked if the DPPO was working because drinking having spread outside the boundary. Tannery Park was being habited by gangs of youths and the police are trying to address this and a representative was meeting with Woodhouse TARA.
- Police are working with Sheffield Homes on a new initiative that keeps a closer look at problem tenants and their tenancy.

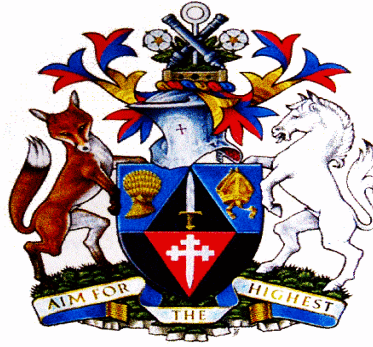
